SAFETY FIRST

- We advise you to thoroughly read and understand all the instructions in this manual before using the hands free car kit while operating a motor vehicle.
- Check and understand the laws regarding use of a cell phone and car kits while driving.
- When using your cell phone with this unit in a vehicle, the unit must be secured at all times.
- Your car kit must never be mounted or stored over airbag areas, as serious injury may result when the airbag deploys.
- If you use the car kit while driving, remain focused on driving and drive in a responsible and safe manner.
- When you are in an area where cell phone use is prohibited, switch your cell phone and *blue tooth* car kit to OFF mode. Areas where this applies include hospitals and fueling stations.
- When refueling always switch off your cell phone and *bluetooth* car kit first. Do not use near any fuel, gas or chemicals. Please power off when advised to do so, for example on airplanes, near medical facilities, or near any area considered hazardous.
- When pairing to another device read and follow all instructions and safety guidelines provided by the manufacturer of the device. Do not pair with incompatible devices.
- The *Bluetooth* car kit is not a toy. Keep away from children. Small parts may be a choking hazard.
- All wireless devices are susceptible to interference or may cause interference, which could affect Usability.

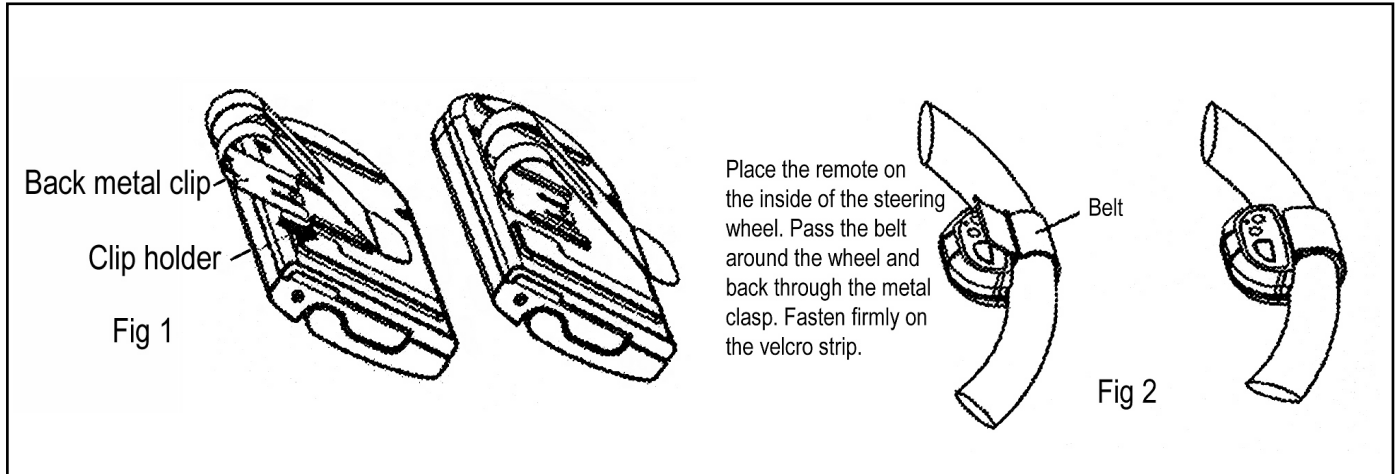

Your Cellmate car kit is compliant with, and adopts *bluetooth* specification 2.0. Compatibility between the car kit and other *bluetooth* enabled devices is not guaranteed and depends on the devices used. Check the details of your cell phone to verify compatibility. Please read and follow the *bluetooth* instructions in your cell phone manual prior to using the car kit.

Getting Started

Attaching the car kit

Attach the Ezitalk car kit to your sun visor using the built-in mounting clip. This is spring loaded and will secure the device to your visor firmly, as in Fig1. Remove by simply pulling the unit off the visor to use in another vehicle, in your office or wherever hands free operation is required.



Next, take the remote control and place on the inside of your steering wheel with the adjustable belt wrapped around the outside of the wheel, as in figure 2 below. Pass the belt through the metal bar on the remote. Once pulled firmly through the metal bar, fix it on the velcro strip. Choose a position that allows comfortable use and that does not obscure your instrument panel.

Main Controls and Functions

Your Ezitalk car kit is equipped with the following controls and functions: (See Figs 3 & 4)

Talk Button: This button performs the following functions: Answer a Call, End a Call, Voice Dial, Last Number Redial, Reject a Call, *bluetooth* reconnect.

Vol- / Vol + Buttons: adjust the volume during a call

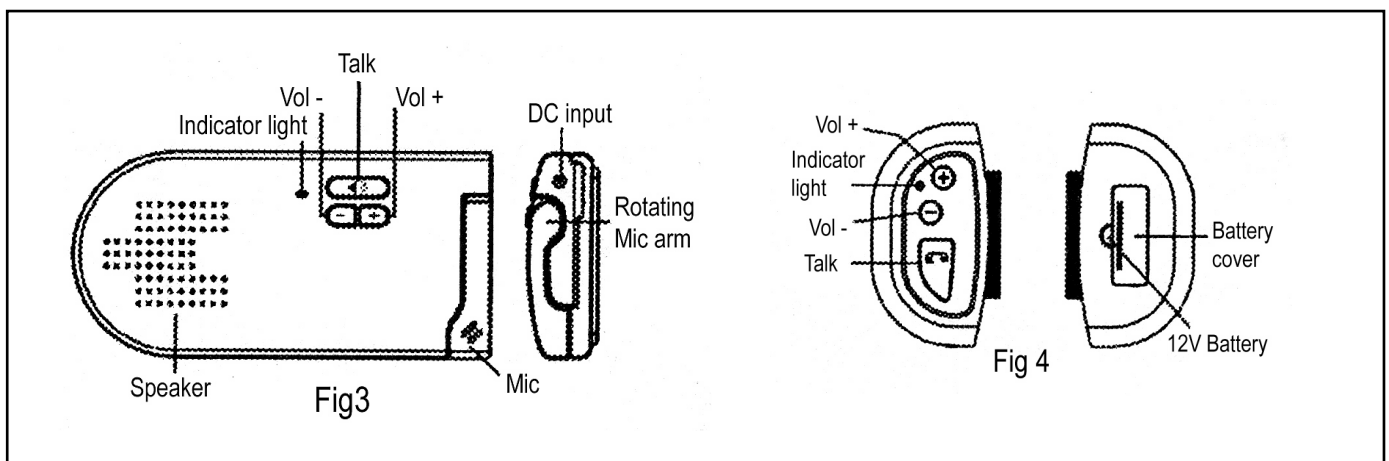
Microphone: The car kit is equipped with an adjustable microphone, located on the right side of the unit. The microphone swings down in normal use providing optimised reception.

Speaker: The car kit has a built-in speaker.

Status: This indicates the car kit's status on calls, battery and charging.

DC Input: Input socket for recharging cable located on top right hand side of car kit. Lights up green when recharging.

Remote: steering wheel remote to answer, reject, voice dial and adjust volume



Pairing your Ezitalk car kit and cell phone

Prior to using your car kit for the first time you must pair it with a *bluetooth* enabled cell phone. The pairing procedure depends on the model of cell phone. Please refer to the user manual of your cell phone for specific details on *bluetooth* connectivity.



The usual pairing sequence is as follows:

- 1 Activate the *bluetooth* function of your cell phone. Refer to the cell phone's User Guide for instructions on *bluetooth* if necessary.
- 2 Turn on your *bluetooth* car kit, and press the talk button for 6 seconds until red and green lights flash alternately. This indicates that your car kit is working in pairing mode.
- 3 Search for *bluetooth* devices with your cell phone. A list of enabled devices within range of the cell phone will be shown. If your cell phone finds the car kit and displays JIAJUN, pairing is successful with the car kit in standby mode and the red light slowly flashing. When prompted enter the passcode connection: 0000

Notes: During pairing, a cell phone and the car kit need to be operated synchronously. If a cell phone is not enabled with the car kit, pairing will fail and your car kit will power off automatically. You will need to repeat the process again. If your cell phone has already connected with another *bluetooth* device, please disconnect it from that device before starting.
If the battery of either the cell phone or the car kit is weak, you may lose the *bluetooth* connection. Maintain battery power to ensure good *bluetooth* connectivity.

Using the Bluetooth car kit

Turning the unit On and Off:

Press and hold the Talk button for 6 seconds until the red and green lights flash alternately. The red light will flash slowly to indicate the unit is on and you are connected. When there are no active functions press the Talk button for at least 3 seconds and the unit will power off.

Microphone:

The microphone is located on the swing arm to the right side of the car kit (see fig3 above). Adjust the microphone in the down position to optimise call voice clarity.

Volume Control:

Use the Volume + - controls to adjust the volume during a call. Further volume control is achieved by turning the call volume on your cell phone up or down.

To Answer and End a Call:

When there is an Incoming Call you will hear a ring tone through the *bluetooth* car kit speaker. Press the Talk button once to answer the call. A green light will flash during the call.

Last Number Redial:

To redial the last dialed number, press the Multi-Function Button twice quickly.

Voice Dialing

To make a voice dialed call press the multi-function button once. Say the Voice Tag clearly after the tone as recorded and the call will be made. NOTE: only works with cell phones equipped with voice dialing and recorded voice tags.

Recharging:

When your car kit battery is low, the green light will flash slowly. Use the 12V car adapter to recharge the car kit, or remove the unit to recharge on the USB port of your computer. The green light will be on when charging and when full charged will turn off. Charging time is 2 to 3 hours. Your car kit is in standby mode while charging.

Remote control unit:

The remote control unit makes for safer and more convenient operation. To answer / reject and adjust volume press the buttons as in fig 4. The remote control unit cannot take the place of the host device to connect or pair.



Troubleshooting

If you are unable to connect the Ezitalk car kit to your cell phone please try the following:

- Refer to your cell phone user guide for specific instructions on pairing.
- Ensure the *bluetooth* car kit is switched ON and is in pairing mode.
- Disconnect your cell phone from all other bluetooth devices.
- Ensure both your *bluetooth* car kit and cell phone has enough battery power to pair successfully.
- Ensure the device is within a maximum of 10 meters of the mobile phone and there are no obstructions such as walls of other electronic devices in between.

If pairing operations fail:

- 1 Delete the item from the paired list on your cell phone.
- 2 Reset both the cell phone and the *bluetooth* car kit device by powering them off and back on.
- 3 Re-pair the two devices.
- 4 Turn off the cell phone and remove the battery from it for approximately five seconds.
- 5 Repeat the pairing process. (Note: in some instances, removing the cell phone battery clears up bugs in the cell phone software that can hinder correct pairing).

If you have connected the *bluetooth* car kit to your cell phone, but do not hear anything:

- Ensure the volume control on the car kit and cell phone is sufficiently high.
- Check the signal strength indicator on your cell phone, as you may be outside the service area.
- Your current location may not provide good call quality. Move to a location where radio signal strength is greater with less interference.
- Magnetized objects placed near the *bluetooth* car kit or near your mobile phone may terminate the call. Keep devices away from such objects.

Care and Maintenance

- Turn your *bluetooth* car kit off when not in use to extend battery life.
- Do not expose your device to liquid, moisture or high humidity as it is not waterproof.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents to clean the device.
- Do not expose the device to extremely high or low temperatures.
- Do not dispose of the device, or its battery pack in a fire as it will result in a explosion.
- Do not disassemble the device as it does not contain serviceable components.
- For storage, keep in a cool, dry place, free from extreme temperatures, dust or dirt.
